



Jones Industrial & Culinary Voc Tech Scholarship

Description

The Jones Dairy Farm Scholarship is funded by Jones Dairy Farm, a long-standing employer in Fort Atkinson with generational ties to the Fort Atkinson community. It is the desire of Jones Dairy Farm to provide highly-motivated Fort Atkinson graduates with an opportunity to pursue an education in a variety of fields in the Industrial Mechanical/Tech Services sector, or in the field of culinary arts.

Full payment of this scholarship is made in one year.

Eligibility

- Eligible students are graduating seniors or graduates of Fort Atkinson High School who are seeking an education in one of the following areas:
 - Industrial Mechanics, Industrial Maintenance
 - Automation Technology
 - Welding
 - Quality Control Technology
 - Facilities Management
 - Laboratory Food Science
 - Culinary Arts
- Are pursuing an educational program in a recognized technical or vocational school in the state of Wisconsin or at the Culinary Institute of America.
- Have maintained, at the time of application for the scholarship, a minimum grade point average of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale in the classes relevant to either industrial mechanics or culinary arts. Students who don't meet the 3.0 GPA threshold may still apply with a strong recommendation from a teacher.

Selection

Applicants will use the Community Foundation's online application process at fortscholarships.applicationsubmit.com.

Selection will be recommended by a committee consisting of a representative of the Fort Atkinson Community Foundation, the Superintendent of the Fort Atkinson School District (or his/her designee), a teacher at Fort Atkinson High School, and a representative from Jones Dairy Farm.

Award

The scholarship award will be paid directly to the school the recipient attends.

The Jones Dairy Farm Scholarship will be awarded at the Awards Day Ceremony at Fort Atkinson High School (usually in late May). If the recipient is a former graduate, they will receive an award letter in the mail.
